

SpellQuest State Level Exam Guideline

We are excited to share the guidelines for the upcoming State-Level SpellQuest Exam. Please read the details carefully to ensure a smooth experience and clear understanding of the exam structure



MARKING SYSTEM TOTAL MARKS = 90

State-Level exam consists of various sections, each aimed at testing different linguistic abilities:

- 1** **Vocabulary Knowledge** Test participant's knowledge of word meanings, synonyms, antonyms, and general vocabulary. 
- 2** **Grammatical Round.** This round will assess grammatical skills, including sentence structure, punctuation, and correct usage of tenses. 
- 3** **Word Cycle** A fun round where students must connect words based on certain clues or themes
- 4** **Word-o-logy** Focuses on word origins, prefixes, suffixes, and root words 
- 5** **Jumble Tumble** Starting letters of words will be given, and students must unscramble or complete them. 
- 6** **Collocation** Students will be tested on word pairings that naturally occur together (e.g., 'make a decision,' 'take a break').
- 7** **Confusing Words** Tests knowledge of commonly confused words (e.g., 'affect vs. effect,' 'accept vs. except').
- 8** **Word Quest** A quest to identify or deduce words based on given definitions or clues
- 9** **Expand Your Lexicon** Multiple-choice questions (MCQs) designed to expand and test students' vocabulary range.

Each Round Comprises of 10 Marks

- **State-Level Competition:** The tentative month for the State-Level SpellQuest Exam is December.
- **Syllabus Information:** Both the Intra-School and State-Level books are eligible for the State-Level exam, so we recommend revising both thoroughly.
- **Qualifying Marks:** A minimum of 60% marks is required to qualify for the National-Level competition.
- **Exam Duration:** 60 minutes.
